Question 1: 1. State's Response: Change. Section III Scope of Work/Specifications Reporting and Documentation is amended as follows:

Question 2: Replace or repair machines in 24 hrs

We cannot guarantee 24 hr turnaround; we can provide a reasonable turnaround but not 24 hrs.

State's Response: Change. Section III Scope of Work is amended as follows:

Contractor shall maintain all equipment in good operating condition. ~~Contractor shall repair or replace equipment within 24 hours of maintenance call from the College.~~ Contractor shall repair or replace equipment within 7 days of maintenance call from the College. Longer repairs or replacements must be requested and approved by the College.
